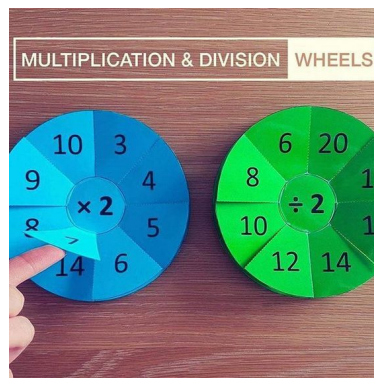

1. Create colourful Multiplication/Division spinning wheels as shown in the image below.



2 **Make A Tangram:** The tangram is a dissection puzzle consisting of seven flat shapes, called tans, which are put together to form shapes. The objective of the puzzle is to form a specific shape using all seven pieces, which may not overlap.



3. Make colourful base for playing 'Tic-Tac-Toe' and number cards of numbers 1-9



4. Shape Sorter- Make colourful cut-outs of at least 12 articles of various shapes and cups for sorting them as shown in the image below.



5. Create colourful cootie catchers based on different mathematical operations as shown in the image below.
