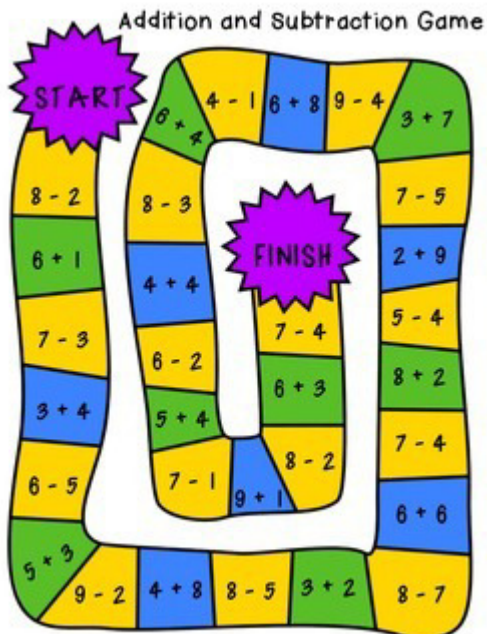
4229- 4234: Operation Puzzle:

1.Math Car Racing:

Take a full chart: Draw start and finish lines. Draw 4 tracks for car racing in different colours. Bring 4 small (hotwheel type) cars.

Make a board game and dice .2 different colour counters.

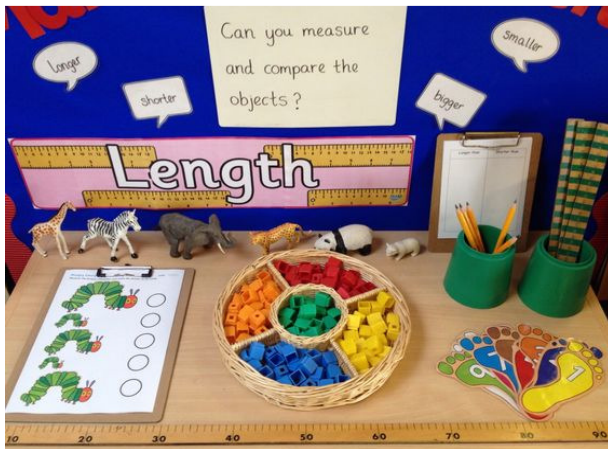
3.Shapes puzzle:



Make cut outs of different shapes to create own scenery or pictures puzzle using these cut outs.

4.Measurement and comparison game:

Make a scale , cut outs of various animals, objects like, pen ,pencil, footprints cut outs of various sizes.



5. Operation Puzzle:

Make 2 piece puzzles (at least 5 of them).

Piece one should have number and operation(For e.g: $2+3$), piece two will have result of the operation(Say for e.g. 5 and should be represented by that many pictures). So when you join the puzzle together $(2+3) = (5)$.
